Flood Alert in Kankai and adjoining Rivers

Date: 2073-07-09 6:00 AM

- Weather has been active in the eastern region of Nepal particularly in Terai Chure and Mid mountain since mid-night
- The Real Time Precipitation station at Mainachuli, Jhapa has recorded 100mm rainfall since 12 AM in the morning till 5 AM. The last 24 hour rainfall in the station is 144mm. which is already above danger level. Other rainfall stations in Kankai River Basin are also recording significant rainfall. The rainfall is continuous and it may continue for some more hours.
- Due to this, Water level in kankai River at Mainachuli Flood Forecasting Station is now rising (3.64m) which is near warning level (3.7m) and the probability of crossing warning level in the coming hours is high.

Hence,

The residence of people living downstream of Kankai river near banks in Satasidham, Surunga, Shivaung, panchgachhi, Mahabhara, Kumarkhod Area of Jhapa District till Nepal India boarder are requested to be in high alert condition.

The residence of People living in hilly region of Jhapa, Ilam and adjoining districts are also requested to be safe from possible landslide or local flooding if you are in high slope or near river banks of local rivers.

Also,

Other small rivers like Mechi, Ninda, Ratuwa, Triyuga and others in the eastern region seems to be flooded. So the residence in those areas are also requested to be safe.
